2. Paralympic athletes.
3. Blind and visually impaired athletes.

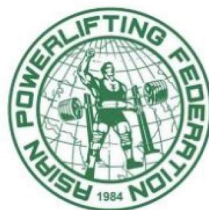

Nominations: Team nomination forms must be completed and submitted to TPF Competition Director Nanthathida Phanphiphat, APF Technical Chairwoman Chen-Yeh Chao, and the APF Competition Secretary PJ Joseph NO LATER than: **March 20, 2020 (later entries will not be accepted).**



Participation Fee: FREE.

Anti-Doping Fee: FREE.

Note 1:

All athletes, coaches, referees or officials from each Federation must stay at the Official Hotel (listed above) during the **entire time** in attendance at the competition. If athletes, coaches, referees or officials do not stay in the official hotel during the entire time in attendance at the competition, they will be obliged to pay an administration fee of **4000 THB** per person to the organizer. Failure to comply will have the effect that they will not receive accreditation and will be excluded from that competition (By-Laws 105.4.4).

Note 2:

The organizer will not be responsible for any hotel bills of the participating Nations. Each Team Manager will be responsible. All rooms must be booked and paid for at the latest with the deadline for the final nomination by **March 20, 2020**. After the deadline, the organizer cannot guarantee the accommodation.

Note 3:

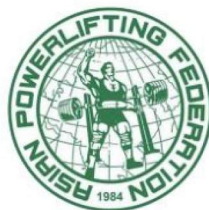
Sub-Junior, Junior, & Master athletes can participate in and receive awards for the Open competition, and only have to compete once, but have to pay participation and anti-doping fee for both categories.

Scales: Scale will be available at the hotel/venue, 24 hours per day.

Training: Training will be available at the hotel/venue for accredited people.

Flag and anthem: Will be provided by the organizer.

Health and Travel Insurance: All delegate members **MUST** have a valid health insurance. The organizer and the IPF will not incur any expenses for a doctor or a stay in hospital. We also recommend travel insurance for covering loss of luggage, theft, delayed planes etc.

Transportation:

Transport from Suvarnabhumi (BKK) airport to hotel: (**1425 THB** each way per car with max of 3 people or **1950 THB** each way per van with a max of 6 people), 45-90 minutes travel. Transport fee is payable in advance, or on arrival in cash (**THB**) only.

Transport from Don Mueang (DMK) airport to hotel: (**1575 THB** each way per car with max of 3 people or **2250 THB** each way per van with a max of 6 people), 45-90 minutes travel. Transport fee is payable in advance, or on arrival in cash (**THB**) only.

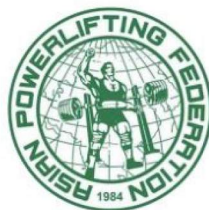

All nominated lifters and officials must cover all hotel costs if we have received no information about a cancellation 14 days prior to the competition, and the same applies for the participation and anti-doping fees (IPF-By-Laws105.5.2).

21 Days Before Technical Meeting: March 20 is the latest date for any removal of nominated lifters or cancellation of booked hotel rooms. If not, Federations are bound to pay the reserved hotel rooms, participation and anti-doping fees for all lifters specified at the final nomination form.

Closing Banquet: Sunday, April 12 at 8pm. Price is **1500 THB** paid in cash or credit card at venue. Payment in advance for banquet tickets is recommended, but the tickets will be available up to 48 hours prior to each.

Important Items to Remember

Preliminary nomination forms must be sent no later than **60 days** before the date of the competition. Final nominations must be submitted no later than **21 days** before the date of the competition and must include only names from the preliminary nomination (i.e. only lifters from the preliminary nomination can be replaced by a substitute. No new nominations will be accepted). According to Technical Rules [Page 4, item 7] at the final nomination you must definitely list the athletes who will take part in the competition. At the Technical meeting you can only delete athletes from your final nomination no more change by weight class of any athlete is possible. The final nomination is valid for the competition.

Changes may occur to the timetable of events. All changes will take place at the technical meeting that will be held on Thursday, April 9 at 6pm. Victory and Award Ceremonies will be held at the end of each lifting session. It will be mandatory that each athlete wear their National Team Warm-up/Track Suit for the award presentation. If the organizer does not receive confirmed cancellations of hotel rooms at least **21 days** prior to the competition, all hotel costs will be the responsibility of nominated lifters and officials. The same applies to participation and anti-doping fees (IPF-By-Laws 105.5.2). All athletes, coaches, referees or officials from each federation must stay in the official hotel during the entire time in attendance at the competition. If athletes, coaches, referees or officials do not stay in the official hotel during the competition, they will be obliged to pay an administration fee of **4000 THB** per person to the organizer. Failure to comply will have the effect that they will not receive accreditation and will be excluded from the competition (IPF By-laws 105.4.4).

Bangkok Highlights

In the morning, you will go to Grand Palace, the most important and impressive royal palace in Thailand. Here, you will see the enigmatic Emerald Buddha, the most revered Buddha image in Thailand. You will then continue to Wat Pho, one of the oldest temples in Bangkok. Wat Pho is renowned for housing the famous 45 meter long reclining Buddha as well as for being the original school of traditional Thai massage and here you will enjoy a 1 hour Thai herbal massage. After that, you will take a long tail boat and cruise along the canal of Thonburi and get a glimpse of the everyday life of the famous 'water people' of Thailand. On your way back, you will stop by what is probably the best known symbol of Bangkok, the Temple of Dawn (Wat Arun), with its sparkling spires covered in broken shards of glass and pottery.

Ayutthaya's glorious ruins and Bang Pa-In Summer Palace

On your way from Bangkok, you will visit the Summer Palace, commonly known as Bang Pa-In, an impressive architectural blend of East and West dating back to the 17th century. You will then explore the glorious ruins of Ayutthaya, which bring back to life the early splendor of the city destroyed by the Burmese army in 1767. During your visit you will stroll around all the most impressive remains of this UNESCO World Heritage Site such as Wat Yai Chai Mongkhon - within the complex resides a huge statue of a reclining Buddha built of brick and stucco, the chedi is bell-shaped and constructed on a mound of raised ground with steps going up to the Buddhist image placed midway to the top. You will then continue with a visit to Wat Mahathat, famed for the head of Buddha which is embedded in a tree trunk and surrounded by the growing roots. Then, you will move onto the bronze Buddha at Wat Phra Mongkhon Bophit which is a thrilling example of the significance of Thai spirituality, before visiting the Royal Monastery – Wat Phra Si Samphet, famous for its three iconic chedis.

Grand Palace + Wat Pho

Today, you will visit the three most remarkable historical landmarks of Bangkok. Your first stop are Wat Phra Kaew and the Grand Palace which are situated in the same compound. While Wat Phra Kaew is the most important temple for Thais, hosting the revered image of the Emerald Buddha; The Grand Palace is an emblematic example of the combination between traditional Thai architectural style and Western style. It is believed that by placing the Emerald Buddha statue in the palace, it would have brought luck to royal family as well as the prosperity and wealth to the whole country. Then, moving on you will come to Wat Pho which is home to more than one thousand Buddha images, as well as the breath-taking perfection of the Reclining Buddha. Wat Pho is also renowned for being the first massage school in Thailand.

Klong Local Discovery with Artist's House

You will discover the canals, or klongs in Thai, an absolute must-visit when exploring what was once referred to as the 'Venice of the East'. Take a boat tour on the klongs in Thonburi, the old Bangkok capital to unveil yet another face of the many faces of Bangkok. Far away from the skyscrapers and dense traffic jams of the new part of the city, Thonburi reveals a more traditional side of Bangkok with old canal wooden townhouses, improbable floating kitchens, charming and glittering temples and an altogether simpler way of life.

This private boat ride is punctuated by a stop at the Baan Silapin Artist's House, a charming traditional house on the canal's edge in a very quiet area and a visit to the famous Temple of Dawn - Wat Arun.

Chinatown Tuk-Tuk food tour with night stroll

Tonight, you will experience real Bangkok lifestyle. You will hop on a tuk tuk and start a twilight tasting adventure into bustling Chinatown. Your driver will let you go for a walk on Yaowarat Road and see its countless and colorful Chinese neon signs. Along lively street food stalls or old shops and hidden family stalls, you will have the opportunity to make new culinary discoveries. Between the smells of spices and dishes simmered in sometimes improvised furnaces, images of burning and flaming stoves, you will be absorbed by the spectacle of these artists of street food, with expert hands shaped by tradition and family know-how. This is a great opportunity to discover simple but unique dishes that are popular with locals. Queue up with hungry foodies and discover some recipes that each have their little stories and anecdotes, and maybe learn how to pronounce their name in Thai.

Continue your evening on your tuk tuk towards Pak Klong Talad, the swarming flower market. Here, when the heat of the day has subsided, the florists, porters, merchants, sellers of betels or other offerings, work to deliver their goods on time for the next day. You will quietly leave this unique and colorful atmosphere for the silence and serenity of a temple and its illuminated stupas at night. A final destination during which you will find some tranquility after the hustle and bustle, before returning to your hotel.
